## 1. Assembly Point: The lobby of Zonar Zagreb hotel

## 2. Scenic spot

### a) Rastoke (Around 1 hour)

- Natural Beauty: The village is built on a limestone plateau, with numerous waterfalls, rapids, and lakes creating a "fairytale" landscape.
- Architectural Heritage: It features traditional wood-shingled houses and water-powered mills, showcasing a unique combination of Dinaric and Posavina architectural styles.
- Ecological Significance: Due to its exceptional natural, cultural, and historical value, it was placed under special protection in 1962.
- Location: Located near the famous Plitvice Lakes National Park, making it a popular stopover for visitors.



### b) Key Aspects of Plitvice Lakes (16 Lakes National Park) (Around 4 hours)

- Location: Situated in the mountainous karst region of central Croatia, between Mala Kapela and Plješivica mountains.
- Unique Geology: The 16 lakes are separated by natural travertine dams (calcium carbonate deposits) created over thousands of years by moss, algae, and bacteria.
- Key Features: The lakes are divided into Upper Lakes (12) and Lower Lakes (4), with colors ranging from azure to green and turquoise. Notable features include the 78-meter high Veliki Slap (Great Waterfall).
- Activities: Visitors can explore via extensive wooden pathways, hiking trails, electric boats, and panoramic trains.
- Status: It is the most popular tourist destination in Croatia, welcoming over one million visitors annually.
